

Guided Catch-and-Release Fishing Trips by Kayak

If you like to kayak and fish, we have the perfect trip for you! Our fishing trips are custom designed to give you the best angling adventure.

The Eastern Upper Peninsula is home to a variety of fish species such as perch, walleye, northern pike, musky, bass, lake trout, steel head, splake, king salmon, and Atlantic salmon to name a few. The most historically and currently sought after Les Cheneaux fish is the perch.

Let us guide you by kayak to the fishing holes that are best for fishing perch and other species. Trips will stay in the interior of the Les Cheneaux islands and explore **perch, bass, and northern pike** habitat.



Woods and Water Ecotours is guided by ecotourism principles of education and low impact natural resource use, so we practice catch-and-release. This means that any fish caught on a trip will be recorded and shared with the Department of Natural Resources Fisheries Department.

Over the years, our area has been researched by universities and the State of Michigan, who have collected important biological information on the fish and habitat requirements in the area. Continuing a great tradition of fisheries research, you will contribute information that helps fisheries management efforts in Les Cheneaux.



Trips will take place on a fishing kayak, and include refreshments, bait, experienced fishing guide and photos of you with your catch. Trips are offered as half or full-day excursions.

Guided Trip options:

Half day- 4 hr-\$145 pp

Full day-6 hour-\$175 pp, includes a healthy lunch

Extra rentals: Wet suit-\$10, Tackle Box-\$15, Fishing Pole-\$15
